North Coast National A&I Society acknowledges the significant bequest received over the past 60 years from the estate of the late George Nesbitt MLA. George Nesbitt (1859-1948) was born in Ireland and migrated to Australia in 1885. In 1895, he settled in Lismore. In 1906, he was elected Mayor of Lismore and in 1913, he was elected as the Member for Lismore in the NSW Parliament. In 1927, he resigned from the Legislative Assembly and was appointed to the NSW Legislative Council serving until 1940. George Nesbitt passed away in 1948.
