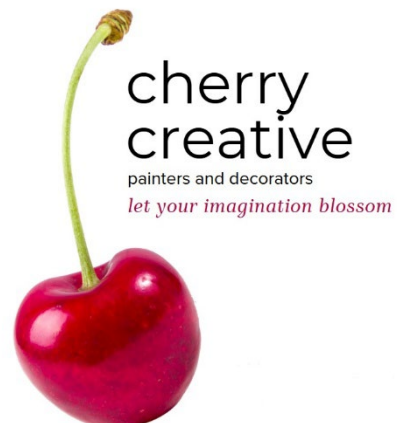

Membership \$65 before 31st August. From 1st of September membership \$70 (2 adults 3 children between 12-18)

All Competitors MUST complete a Horse Health Declaration AND a waiver. These are available on the website www.northcoastnational.com.au Entrygate or by emailing office@northcoastnational.com.au or at the ring office on the day

HORSE SPECIAL REGULATIONS

- 1.No person under disqualification recognized by this Association may exhibit or compete.
- 2.Horses are to enter the Lismore Showgrounds via Dunoon Road gate only.
- 3.Horses will not be permitted on the grounds before Monday 13th October 2026
- 4.Age of all horses to be calculated as at 1st August.
- 5.The Society is not responsible for the non-delivery of Sponsor's trophies
- 6.No ribbon other than those awarded at the 2026 North Coast National Exhibition to be exhibited in the Grand Parade
- 7.Competitors age, as at the day of the event (See Showjumping regulation for Junior competitors)
- 8.Lismore Showground is outside the Cattle Tick Protected Area: Competitors from QLD are advised to contact their local Stock Inspector to clarify the current requirements needed to make the necessary arrangements for border crossings. Crossings are to be made in daylight hours. QLD exhibitors will need to make the necessary arrangements for their return entry into QLD The cost of spraying etc, will be borne by the Exhibitor.
- 9.All special prizes are subject to Committee's approval
- 10.All exhibits must be presented in Show condition to the satisfaction of the stewards
- 11.Random drug testing may be carried out at this Show
- 12.All horse owners will be required to supply a PIC number for their property, or the property where the horse is kept
- 13.Any competitor found to have breached the A.S.C. Disputes and disciplinary regulations will be investigated by the A.S.C Disciplinary Committee.
14. Horses competing in breed classes must be registered with a recognised Stud Book of the breed and the exhibitor must be a current financial member of the relevant breed society where required. Registration papers must be produced to the Ring Steward upon request.
- 15.For full Society Rules please contact the North Coast National A&I Society Inc

16. Should there be any reason to suspect that any Exhibit is either diseased or dangerous, or objectionable, the Society through its Officials, reserves the right of removing the same from or refusing its admittance to the North Coast National Exhibition

Exhibition

17. Persons who are considered by the Ringmaster or Chief Steward to be abusive or cruel to a horse will be expelled from the ground.

18. **Approaching Judges:** No exhibitor or associate will initiate conversation with a judge on judging day, before, during or after judging except through the Ringmaster or Chief Steward.

19. **Prohibited Relationship:** No competitor will present for judging before a judge with whom he/she has a family relationship, has, or has recently had a personal relationship or has had horse related business dealings during the past twelve months.

20. **Coaching:** Any person detected coaching a competitor while that competitor is being judged may be removed from the Showground.

21. **Proper Conduct:** Any person who behaves offensively on the Showground may be expelled from the ground. The matter may be investigated by the Society or/and the AgShows NSW Disciplinary committee, and penalties may be imposed.

22. The North Coast National A&I Society Inc shall not be responsible for any loss or damage caused (inter alia) through disease or infection howsoever arising.

23. No Entry is required for Champion prizes.

24. In all judging of Reserve Champions, the horse which gained second place to the horse awarded the Championship is eligible for Reserve Champion.

25. National Coast National LGA is limited to both HORSE & RIDER residing in the Lismore Government Area (LGA)

26. Events will be carried out at the stipulated time, notwithstanding the absence of any exhibitor.

27. **Lateness to the Ring:** Competitors must be ready when called. Once judging has commenced, a competing horse shall not be led, or ridden, into or out of the judging ring without the permission of the judge and/or the Ringmaster or Chief Steward.

28. **Leaving The Ring:** If a led horse should drag or escape its handler or a ridden or driven horse take control of or unseat its rider and leave the ring, it is usually disqualified from the class.

29. Where second prizes are offered and two exhibits compete, it is the Judge's discretion to award the second prize.

30. The committee has the right to alter the program or type of event if considered necessary.

31. The Senior Stewards in charge of judging rings are empowered with the approval of the Chief Ring Steward to exclude any competitor without explanation.

32. Tickets for entry to all events will be sold each day of the Exhibition from the Ring Control Office (not Show Secretary's office). No refunds and no competitor may enter an event without a ticket.

33. **Prize Money:** Horse events - Prize money must be collected on the day of the event and will be paid from the **Ring office**. Payment only issued on presentation of single voucher from ring stewards. Show Jumping paid in the Show Jumping Ring.

34. **Novice** exhibits must not have won an Open Championship in the same discipline at any Agricultural Show. Intermediate Hacks must not have won an Open First Place at a Royal Show or a Champion title at a Horse of the Year Show.

35. **Ridden Show Hunters and Ridden Show Hacks:** At the beginning of each calendar year an exhibitor MUST choose the category for their exhibit, EITHER Show Hunter or Show Hack, when competing at an AgShows NSW Affiliated Agricultural Show or supplementary event.

36. **Ridden Show Hunters: Hack, Galloway, Pony:** Horses in Show Hunter classes may not also compete in Ridden Show Hack classes.
44. **Show Hunters** cannot compete in Open show Horse Hack Sections. They must choose to either Show Hunter or Open.
37. All competitors must be suitably attired for their events.
38. **Helmets:** Every rider is encouraged to wear a safety helmet compliant with the current Australian Standard. **Riders under 18 years MUST** wear a compliant safety helmet. Some EA affiliated events require Rider's helmets to be tagged prior to competition.
39. **Footwear:** All competitors must wear appropriate footwear when leading or riding a horse. When riding, the footwear must enable removal of the foot from the stirrup.
40. As requested by our insurer, all exhibitors must sign an indemnity/waiver or, in the case of exhibitors under 18 years of age, a parent or guardian must sign prior to competing. All competitors must also complete a Record of Attendance form prior to competing. Upon signing the indemnity/waiver, the competitor will be issued with a wristband which must be worn at all times whilst on the Showgrounds.
41. Access to the Centre Ring is **strictly** limited to exhibitors currently competing, authorised officials, judges, stewards and approved personnel. Unauthorised persons are prohibited from entering the Centre Ring at any time.
41. All Prize Money: 1st - \$10, 2nd - \$5
42. Unless advised elsewhere Ribbons will be presented to 3rd place
43. Saturday - The winner of the Champion for individual rings is not eligible to compete in any further rings.
46. Entry fee is \$5.00 (incl G.S.T) per entry unless otherwise stated.
47. North Coast national Zone 1 includes the following. Alstonville, Bangalow, Bonalbo, Casino, Grafton, Kyogle, Lismore, Murwillumbah, Nimbin, Mclean and Woodenbong.

Stabling

1. All Stables will be locked, stabling & camping **MUST BE PRE-BOOKED & PAYMENT MUST BE RECEIVED** at the North Coast National office 4pm Tuesday the 13th of October 2026 (no exceptions). Application form available at www.northcoastnational.com.au
2. A limited number of stalls are available - please complete the stall application form and return to show office by the above date (Tuesday 13th October). If you are sleeping on the grounds, you must pay for camping
3. In the event of any person placing horses in boxes or stalls or removing numbers without authority, the horse will at once be removed from the Showground by order of the Ring Committee.
4. No stall or box shall be used other than for the animal for which it has been allocated to, and in the event of a breach of this contract the Society may at any time re-allot the box to another competitor.
5. The allocation of stalls and feed rooms and the movement of horses and gear to and from such stalls and rooms shall be under control of the stable steward.
6. Exhibitors not following the instructions of the Stable Steward in relation to the above may be barred from competing and the animals concerned must be removed from the showground forthwith.
7. A limited number of stalls are provided. Please complete the stall application form and return to the show office by the advertised date.
8. Horses will be measured at the Stewards discretion.
9. Please apply for camping space when making stall application please refer to Stable Application in this booklet, payment must accompany booking.
10. **All bedding requirements to be supplied by exhibitor eg. sawdust. NO STRAW ALLOWED**
11. **DOGS** brought onto the grounds must be under strict control and will be the responsibility of the owner.
12. Horses showing any type of tick will not be allowed onto the grounds, (including grass ticks)

Stallion Safe Practice Regulations

- 1.Stallions cannot compete with Geldings or Mares in Hack or Riding Classes
- 2.Stallions should wear official "discs" at all times whilst on the Lismore Showgrounds. These discs are to be worn on both sides of head collars and bridles or on same part of the horse on both sides to identify to others that the horse is a stallion
- 3.No stallion is to be moved around the Lismore Showground without displaying the stallion discs and a suitable restraint with a bit. The restraint can be a bridle, a rearing bit or a chain lead rein over the nose or under the jaw but MUST have a bit.
- 4.Where possible all stallions are to be stabled. If suitable stabling is not available stallions need to wear a collar, which is securely tied to the outside of a truck or trailer. Stallions tied to the outside of a truck or trailer MUST be supervised at all times.
- 6.Stallions may be substituted in prize-giving ceremonies with another horse should the rider deem it to be safer.
- 7.Riders and handlers of stallions at shows be over the age of 17 years
- 8.It is the stallion owner's/rider's responsibility to ensure that all possible safety precautions are taken.
- 9.Floats/trucks that transport stallions should display the official magnet giving notice that there is a stallion on board.
- 10.The use of **ELECTRIC TAPE IS NOT** allowed on the showgrounds by order of the Society

PROTESTS

- 1.A protest or complaint against any exhibit or exhibitor may be lodged verbally with the **RINGMASTER** no later than ten minutes after judging
- 2.The Ringmaster or Chief Steward must be provided with the details of the complaint and act, if necessary, to maintain complete fairness
- 3.The Ringmaster or Chief Steward may choose to refer the matter to the protests Committee which shall comprise the president of the society and two other members of the general committee
- 4.A protest or complaint or an appeal against the decision of the Ringmaster or Chief Steward may be lodged in writing with the secretary no later than 10 pm on the day of judging Such protest, appeal or complaint shall be accompanied by a deposit of \$50.00 which shall be forfeited if the protest, complaint or appeal proves Frivolous or vexatious
- 5.A matter lodged this way shall be dealt with by the Protests Committee within 24 hours of lodgment and the decision of the Protest committee shall be final NB: No protest or complaint will be considered if it refers simply to a judge's decision

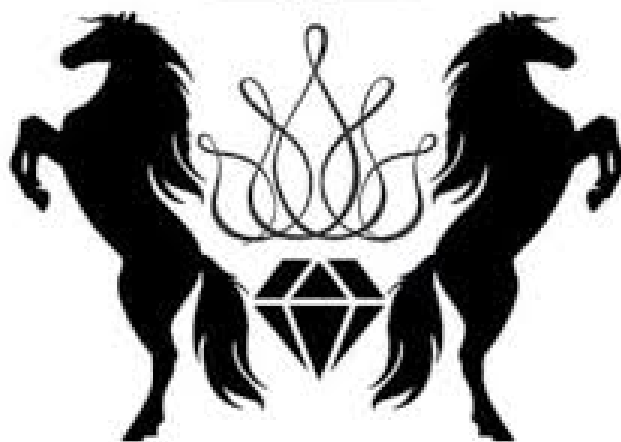

SHOWJUMPING

Showjumping Regulations:

Competitors will be permitted to enter their horses on the day of the event.

All competitors MUST forward names and registration number of each show jumping horse on stall application.

No prize money will be paid until registration card is presented to Stewards. This rule will be strictly enforced.

Stallions must wear official disks at all times while at the Lismore Showground and are required to wear either a halter or bridle WITH A BIT.

Prize money to be collected from the Ring office

The Show jumping events at the 2026 Exhibition will be conducted under EA National Jumping Rules and Regulations in conjunction with the applicable special Society rules.

Horses competing in events 1.04m and Under MUST be Base Registered

ENTRY FEES to be paid when accepted each morning.

Competitors may take part in competition of juniors from the beginning of the calendar year they reach 12yrs until end of calendar year they reach 18yrs.

Junior competitors 16yrs and over must be registered with the E.A. to compete in senior events. All competitors must appear in clean hunting costume in show jumping events

(business or polo shirt & tie); Helmets must be worn approved under Standards Effective from January 2026 Tagging will be available at the show and is able to be done on the day
