1. Entries open to all members of all Rural Youth Clubs up to and including 30 years of age as of 1st January, 2026
2. All exhibits in pavilion section must be delivered to the stewards at the Fine Arts Pavilion prior to judging times on previous page. The Fine Arts Pavilion may not be open for the public until 10.30 am on Thursday 15th October 2026
3. Stud Beef Cattle will be judged on Friday 16th October 2026 at 3-3.30 pm
4. The Pavilion will be open for collection of exhibits from 9.00 am to 11 am Sunday 18th October 2026
5. All work must be completed within the last three years with the exception of Photography, which must have been taken in the last 12 months.
6. All entries must be forwarded to the Show Secretary or submitted online through our website or via Showday
7. NO LATE ENTRIES ACCEPTED.
8. ENTRIES WILL BE CERTIFIED AS BEING THE COMPETITOR'S OWN EFFORT BY THE ORGANISER OR BY THE MEMBER OF THE ADVISORY COMMITTEE CHOSEN FOR THE PURPOSE. Only bona-fide members of a Rural Youth Club will be allowed to compete in any class.
9. All agricultural produce must have been grown by the exhibitor.

General information

1. All possible care will be taken of exhibits, but the Society will not be responsible in anyway for loss or damage
 2. The Judge's decision will be final in all classes
 3. Juniors are eligible to enter in senior sections

All Exhibits to comply with regulations in open sections

1. Tick Regulations - Lismore Showground is outside the cattle tick protected area, no restrictions on movement outside of tick protection area.
2. Johnes Regulation - All cattle must comply with Johnnes Regulations and must have NLIS tags inserted as they will be scanned (Lismore Showground PIC No.NK537983)
3. All cattle must be tested for pestivirus and a copy of the lab report attached to the entry form
4. Age of all Beef Cattle as 1st October
5. All cattle (Beef & Dairy) must be the result of the Exhibitors husbandry for at least 3 months prior to the show date. All Cattle (Beef & Dairy) must be pure bred,
6. Cattle exhibited by a Rural Youth member must not be exhibited in any open classes under any other name (eg. Parent), however, the animal may still be registered under the family breeders assoc. name.
7. Project books must be entered in Pavilion section and then to be collected and produced with the Cattle where stated in schedule for judging

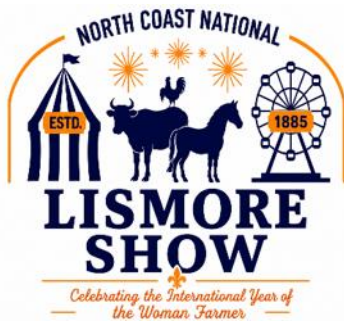
