CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Entries close – Friday, 13 September 2024. No late entries will be accepted.

Entry forms must be returned to Show Office or posted to Secretary, North Coast National A & I Society Inc, PO Box 109, Lismore, 2480 or emailed by the above date.

Entry fee – TURSA Art Prize: \$10 per entry (includes GST). Cheques to be made payable to “North Coast National A & I Society Inc.”

All work must be original and executed by the exhibitor unaided, within the past two years and not have won a prize in any exhibition previously. No copies or artworks done with assistance in workshops or classes etc will be acceptable in any section. Works must not have been shown previously at the TURSA Art Prize.

No more than eight (8) entries per person and only one accepted at maximum size per section (100 x 100cm).

No changes allowed after entry. Entry fees are non-refundable.

Only traditional art mediums are accepted, ie, paint, pastel, pencil, linocut etc. No photography or digital art accepted.

See our Fine Arts Schedule if you are a photographer or a digital visual artist.

All artwork entered must be for sale. A commission of 20% from the indicated price of the exhibit will be deducted by the Society.

Delivery time for works – Monday, 14 October from 9am to 2pm. Artworks to be delivered to the Gem Club Pavilion, Lismore Showgrounds (unless special arrangements have been made for early delivery). Artwork may be forwarded to the Showground Office, Alexandra Parade, Lismore 2480 by post or courier and will be returned at the artist's expense. Every care will be taken of exhibits by the Society, but no responsibility will be accepted for loss or damage. If desired, exhibitors can arrange their own insurance at their own expense.

Artworks must be ready for safe display with 2 x D rings (min. size 1cm) 5–7cm from the top of each artwork. As artworks are hung from the D rings, any hanging wire must be loose enough to allow access to the D rings. No screw eyes accepted.

All works must be dry and not exceed 100cm in either direction including the frame.

TURSA ART PRIZE SCHEDULE

Artworks without suitable safe hanging apparatus, unsuitably framed, oversized or not meeting any Condition of Entry WILL NOT be accepted. The Committee reserves the right to withhold any entry which it considers unsuitable.

If a dispute arises not covered by the Conditions of Entry, the decision of the Committee will be final.

The back of each artwork MUST show the following: Title of Artwork, Section entered, Price, Name of exhibitor, Address and Phone number.

The decision of the Judge shall be final. The Committee reserves the right to cancel any section if there are less than 5 entries. The individual artwork will be allocated to the next appropriate section.

All artworks are to be displayed for the duration of the exhibition. If too many entries are received, selection for hanging in the Gem Club Pavilion will be decided by the Committee. Excess entries may be displayed elsewhere if space permits. All entries that meet the Conditions of Entry will be judged and every effort will be made to exhibit all entries.

Pick up – artworks will be released between 9am and 11am, Sunday, 20 October – no works released on Saturday. Works not collected on Sunday will be available from the Secretary’s Office from **Monday, 21 October until Friday, 25 October.**

PROOF OF IDENTIFICATION WILL BE REQUIRED TO COLLECT ARTWORKS. All paintings not collected by 5pm on Monday, 21 October remain at owner’s own risk.

Prize Money – all prize money will be transferred into the artist’s nominated bank account. Bank account details must be provided to the Secretary’s Office prior to 31 October. No prize money will be paid after 15 November. Any vouchers to be collected from the Secretary’s Office if not presented to the artist at the Awards Evening.

The Committee reserves the right to have any work reproduced (without fee) in the press and on television, the Society’s website and social media. The artist is responsible for ensuring that no relevant copyright laws are infringed. The signed entry form is evidence of the artist’s consent.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Entries close – Friday, 13 September 2024. No late entries will be accepted.

Entry forms must be returned by the above date to the address on the TURSA/ Youth Art Entry Form.

Entry fee – free

The entry must be the exhibitor's own original work and have been completed in the previous two years.

Only traditional art mediums are accepted, ie, paint, pastel, pencil, linocut etc. No photography or digital art accepted.

Entries must be framed or on canvas with 2 x D rings (1cm minimum).

The back of each artwork MUST show the following: Title of Artwork, Section entered, Price, Name of exhibitor, Address and Phone number.

Delivery time – for artworks is Monday, 14 October from 9am to 2pm. Artworks to be delivered to Gem Club Pavilion, Lismore Showgrounds.

Artworks may be posted or couriered to the Showground Office, Alexandra Parade, Lismore 2480 and will be returned at the artists' expense.

Artworks will be released between 9am and 11am, Monday, 21 October – no works released on Saturday. Works not collected on Sunday will be available from the Showground Office from Monday, 21 October until Friday, 25 October during business hours.

Any prize money or vouchers to be collected from the Showground Office if not presented at Awards Evening.
